FORM 1 – LUASS™ Scheme Registration

GUIDE TO COMPLETION OF FORM 1 – To be used for Light UAS of 150 Kg and below.

Please note that Registration is type specific – you may register any quantity of Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) of the same type on the same form. If you have more than one type of UAS to register please use a separate Form 1 for each type.

Form 1 is intended for completion by the **Manufacturer, Distributor, Operator and Pilots & Crew** of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS). **Form 1 (web edition)** is in PDF format and can be completed on-line or off-line. Save a copy on your local drive, open and enter the information requested – for security purposes we suggest you save frequently.

Sections to be completed by the Principal Point of Contact acting on behalf of one or more of the following organization types:

- **Manufacturer: Section 1, 3, 4, 5, 6**

Note: Manufacturers hold design authority for the UAS and are the organization which performs final assembly. Manufacturers are responsible for issuing specifications, maintenance schedules, operating procedures & limits, software updates and warning bulletins. Manufacturers can also act as a Distributor and/or an Operator.

- **Distributor: Section 1, 3, 4, 5, 6**

Distributors are part of the logistics chain importing and/or distributing UAS to Operators. They may hold limited authority to undertake factory authorized repairs and replacements. Distributors are responsible for passing on to their customers the manufacturer's original documentation including Design & Construction Certificates issued by EuroUSC™.

- **Operator: Section 1, 3, 4, 5, 6**

Note: The Operator is the individual or Organization which flies the UAS under a permission or exemption.

- **Pilots & Crew: Section 2, 3, 6**

The Pilot (Pilot in Command) of the UAS is responsible for the direct control of the aircraft in flight. Crew members work with and support the Pilot during a 'mission'. Assessment of **Pilots** and **Crew**, where applicable, is based on ability to work and act within a team environment. The Basic National Unmanned Certificate (BNUC™ or BNUC-S™) is UAS type specific and is awarded to Pilots and Crew who can demonstrate the required skills and knowledge. BNUC™ is in two parts a. Theory test (Ground School Examination) and b. Skills test (Flight Test Examination).

Registration of Pilots and Crew **is currently FREE** – please enter the quantity of Pilots/Crew in Section 2. Following submission of Form 1 we will forward sufficient copies of Form 10 'APPLICATION FOR THE BNUC-S/BNUC QUALIFICATION UNDER THE LIGHT UAS SCHEME (LUASS™)' to enable Pilots/Crew to apply for the qualification.
